

Small Group Sermon Questions for the week of 11/13/22 ~ 1 Corinthians 15:50-58

- 1) In a world where it sometimes seems that death is victorious, how do you “keep the faith” and “seek first the kingdom”? (Bonus: Is God’s Kingdom your first kingdom?)

- 2) We don’t much like to talk about death. How has death been spoken about in your experience, either in ways more beneficial or less so? What’s this say about our hope?

- 3) Read 2 Peter 3:3-10. Even then, people were confused about the timing of the return of Jesus. Has the “Delay of Christ’s Return” ever bothered you? Why or why not?

- 4) It’s estimated that 1 in 15 of all the people who have ever lived are alive now. How does this affect your thinking on the “delay of Christ’s return”? Pray for more time?

- 5) Paul talks about sin & the Law in the context of death? Is the Law of God evil? A blessing? Our schoolteacher? All three? How does our belief about salvation condition our evaluation and understanding of the Law?

- 6) Read Matthew 6:19-21 & 31-34. Paul says, “your labor in the Lord is not in vain.” How are you seeking His Kingdom, and what are the treasures you are storing up?
