Luke 14:25-35

The questions below are discussion starters based on this week's sermon. Use them to keep your folks engaged with the worship, scripture, and with one another.

1. It is impossible to read the Bible literally. Reading the Bible in context and reading the Bible with sound theology absolutely matters. How so? How does our passage demonstrate that?
2. What three things does Jesus say if we are to be disciples?
3. What does Jesus mean when he says "Unless we hate" our family we cannot be his disciples?
4. What does it mean to carry our cross?
5. What does Jesus expect his disciples to do with money and possessions?
6. If people were to observe us for a week, would they believe that Jesus is our highest and ultimate authority in how we revere him, how we obey him, how we handle our money, possessions, and time?
7. How can you narrow the gap between how we live and how Jesus calls us to live?
8. In order for salt to be salty it must dissolve. What is the correlation to what it means to be a disciple of Jesus?
