1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 16:1-24

The questions below are discussion starters based on this week's sermon. Use them to keep your folks engaged with the worship, Scripture, and with one another.

1. Money is a tool. How can we use money as a tool for the kingdom of God?
  
2. Is our world better because of the way we use money? Is our family better because of the way we use money? Is our church?
  
3. "Money simply accomplishes what the holder desires." What is money accomplishing in your life for the kingdom?
  
4. How can we use money so that our world, family, and church is better? What are some practical things we can do to use money as a tool for the kingdom of God?
  
5. What's the big deal with money? Why does it matter? What is the connection between the way we use money and our spirituality?
  
6. Surely, we don't have silly things like the chair or the ladders in the modern-day church...right? If we do, what are our chairs and ladders?
  
7. Keep the main thing the main thing...What is the main thing?
  
8. Have you seen a church forget her main thing? What happened?
