

Small Group Sermon Questions for the week of 11/6/22

1st Corinthians 15:35-49

The questions below are discussion starters based on this week's sermon. Use them to keep your folks engaged with the worship, Scripture, and with one another.

- 1) How have you pictured Heaven and eternity with God in the past? Do you think that your imagination of Heaven is too small, or conditioned by culture & literature more than by the Bible?

- 2) Look at Jesus' appearance to His disciples after His resurrection (Luke 24). What do you notice?

- 3) Why is it important to know that Jesus rose bodily? What difference does that make?

- 4) Read I John 3:1-3. How does this augment your hope in the resurrection?

- 5) Read Romans 8:18-25. Is your hope in things present or things to come—in things of earth or things of God? How does this affect your response to difficulties and loss?

- 6) Christmas is coming, when we celebrate the Incarnation of Jesus—His entry into the life we live. How important is it that Jesus came "in the flesh"?

- 7) Read Colossians 3:1-3. How can we bear the image of the heavenly man more fully and faithfully (I Cor 15:49)?
