1st Corinthians 6:12-20

The questions below are discussion starters based on this week's sermon. Use them as a way to keep your folks engaged with the worship, Scripture, and with one another.

1. What was your most impactful takeaway from the sermon?
2. "You can't make sense of the way something is to be used without understanding what it was made for." How does this apply to our lives? How does this inform how we are to use our bodies?
3. Why does context matter?
4. How can true sayings and statements like, "Forgiveness is extended before repentance is expressed," lead to confusion?
5. What is the big deal about sex? How is sexual sin different than other sins?
6. "It's my body." How is this not true for Christians? That our bodies are not our own...what does that mean for Christians? How are we to use our bodies?
7. Are there ways people can dishonor God through the use of their bodies apart from sexual sins?
8. What are some practical ways you can honor God with your body?
